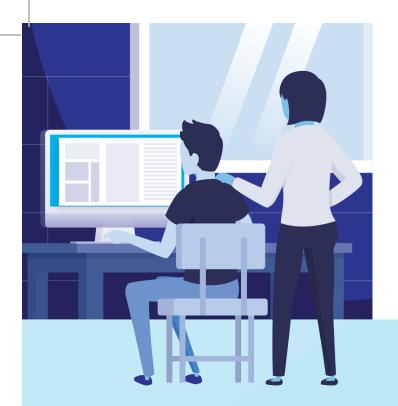












### **TEAM RULES**
